Creative Picture Making – Watercolour to Pastel

In this course, we will explore the exciting combination of drawing and painting with watercolour and soft pastels. Using a variety of subject matter, the emphasis will be placed upon creating exciting, colourful, inspirational pictures, to develop and express your creative ideas and interpretation of your subject. The classes will be suitable for all abilities. Individual assistance and advice will be given, appropriate to whatever stage you may be at on your picture-making journey.

Back to Basics in a Victorian Art School and Beyond

The course will begin with a traditional approach to drawing and (it is hoped) develop into something more personal. Victorian Art Schools, before allowing students to participate in drawing from life, would give students sessions involving drawing from plaster casts of Greek and Roman figures. We will start the first session working from photocopies of conventional classical figure sculptures and hopefully complete a drawing in pencil on the first day. Having done the hard work, samples and suggestions will be discussed to help you decide how you would like to develop the drawing as a personal response and what media you would like to experiment with. Traditional or whacky, you choose! Suitable for all abilities: complete beginners or those who would like to improve on skills they learned years ago.

- **Priority will be given to applicants that can attend all 3 classes, but if space allows, there may be a possibility to attend 1 or 2 sessions only.**
- **We will allocate the 18 places on these courses in the order of receipt of Booking Forms. Please return your Booking Form as soon as possible, and no later than Thursday 1st January 2026.**
- **Once the courses are full, we will contact you to ask whether you wish to be placed on the waiting list.**
- **If you are allocated a place on the course, further details will be sent out prior to the start of each course.**
